## MISSION POLICY FOR VOLUNTEERS

**PURPOSE:** To communicate the Mission’s policy and philosophy concerning the interaction of volunteers with the guests that stay at the Mission.

**POLICY:** The Central Wyoming Rescue Mission has been established as a Christian, non profit, philanthropic organization that offers a holistic approach in dealing with homeless individuals and families. In keeping with our desire for professionalism and effective assistance, all in a loving Christian atmosphere, any personal dealings between guests and volunteers is deemed not to be in the guest’s best interest.

**PROCEDURES:**

All volunteers of the Mission are not to engage in any personal relationships with any guest of the Mission for one (1) year after the guest has left the mission.

- A. No volunteer is permitted to take any Mission guest from the Mission without prior administrative staff approval.
- B. There is to be no personal, social, or business relationship between Mission volunteers and Mission guests for one (1) year after the guest has left the mission. You are encouraged to keep a professional distance.
- C. Mission volunteers are not to buy, sell, or store any item from a Mission guest, nor give money directly to them.
- D. The transport of any Mission guest by any Mission volunteer must have prior approval from the administrative staff.
- E. Failure to follow this policy by any Mission volunteer is grounds for dismissal.

As a volunteer of the Central Wyoming Rescue Mission, I have read, understand, and agree to abide by these policies.
